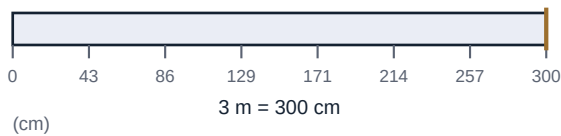

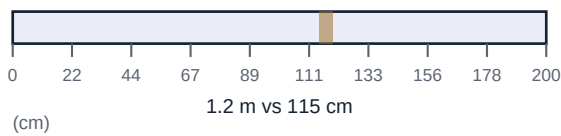
3. Convert 2 kg to g.
